5-215.1 of the Natural Resources Article, as enacted by Section 1 of this Act, in the
form of a proposed regulation.

18 2002, the Department of Natural Resources, in consultation with the Deep Creek

19 Lake Policy and Review Board, shall report to the Senate Economic and
